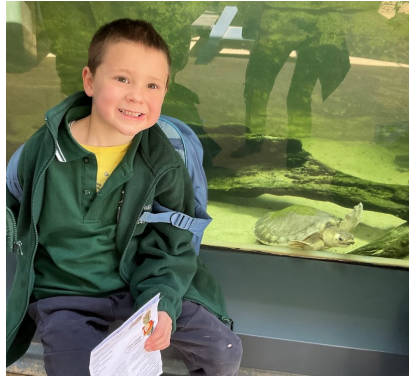

Golden Syrup Dumplings

- 1 cup S.R flour
- 1 egg (if liked)
- Sufficient milk to make a stiff dough
- 1 tablespoon butter
- Pinch salt

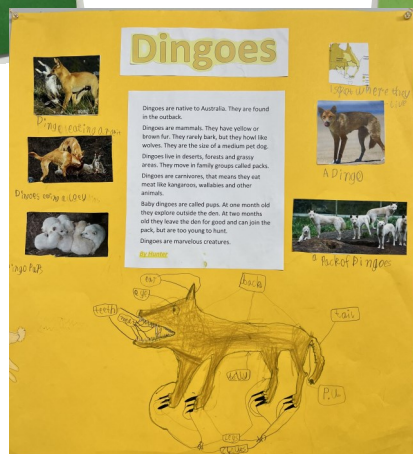
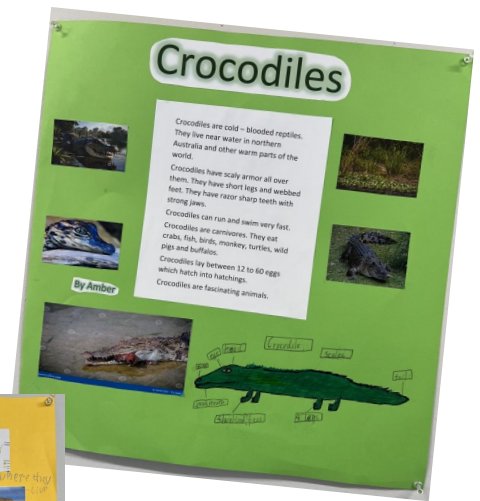
1. Sift flour & salt, rub in butter.
2. Add sufficient liquid (milk & egg) to make a stiff dough
3. Drop dessert spoonful into syrup and cook 20 - 30 minutes
4. Serve with custard, cream or ice cream

Syrup

- 2 cups of boiling water
- ½ cup sugar
- 1 tablespoon of butter and golden syrup.
- Mix all ingredients together
